This magical musical night features a star-studded list of Olympic and world-class figure skaters. Skaters confirmed for the one-time collaboration include Olympic silver medalist **Sasha Cohen**, Olympic gold medalist **Brian Boitano**, six-time U.S. champion **Todd Eldredge**, world champion **Yuka Sato**, three-time U.S. champion **Michael Weiss**, world ice dancing champion **Shae-Lynn Bourne**, six-time Canadian champion **Jennifer Robinson**, Olympic pairs champions **Jamie Sale and David Pelletier** and two-time world silver medalist dancing champions **Marie-France Dubreuil and Patrice Lauzon**.

The Cleveland Pops Orchestra, with conductor **Carl Topilow**, has been entertaining audiences throughout greater Cleveland and Northeast Ohio for thirteen years. They are renowned for their exciting and innovative blend of popular music, standards, Broadway show tunes, movie scores, Swing, Big Band and Jazz performances.

Peter Cetera is perhaps best known as one of the original members of the rock band, Chicago. He eventually embarked on a solo career that included numerous trips to the top of the Billboard charts. Among his No. 1 hits are “Glory of Love,” which was the theme song to the movie, “Karate Kid II,” “The Next Time I Fall,” a Grammy Award-nominated love ballad he performed with Amy Grant and “Restless Heart.” He has performed with numerous musical stars, ranging from David Foster to Billy Joel and his work has been nominated for Grammy and Academy Awards.
